Welcome to the GOLDEN GOLF COURSE **NORDIC SKI TRAILS!**

The golf course Nordic ski trails are maintained by the Golden Nordic Ski Club, a non-profit society, with the gracious support of the Golden Golf Club.

To ensure continued access to Golden golf course ski trails, please STAY ON TRAILS as venturing off-trail will damage summer use.

Grooming and trail maintenance is conducted by the Golden Nordic Ski Club for the enjoyment of all cross-country skiers of all abilities.

Location

The golf course Nordic ski trails are located 6 km from the centre of Golden and 14 km from Dawn Mountain Nordic Centre on the west side of the Columbia River. From town, cross the Columbia River towards Kicking Horse Mountain Resort and turn right onto Golf Course Drive. Stay right to remain on Golf Course Drive until the parking lot at the end of the road.

Trail Fees

Day-use fees are by cash donation at the trailhead. If you are not a member of the Golden Nordic Ski Club, we suggest \$2 per person. Fees go towards maintaining and grooming the ski trail system.

Ski Prepared

Skiers using the golf course ski trails assume all responsibility for injury or damage to equipment resulting from the use of the ski trails. For safety, ski with a friend, bring a phone, wear adequate clothing, and bring food and water.

Trail Conditions

Grooming and trail conditions report is posted on goldennordicclub.ca/conditions.

Dawn Mountain Nordic Centre

Located just past Kicking Horse Mountain Resort, the club maintains 33+ km of groomed classic and skate ski trails. For ski equipment rentals, lessons, membership, and youth programs (starting at age 3), contact Dawn Mountain Chalet. Rental equipment is to be used only at Dawn Mountain Nordic Centre.

Trail Etiquette

- Trails are track-set for classic cross-country skiing only.
- NO skate skiing, walking, snowshoeing, or fat biking on the ski trails.
- DOGS are NOT permitted.
- STAY ON THE TRAILS! No off-trail travel anywhere on the golf course, including fairways, greens, and tees.
- Skiers going downhill have the right of way.
- Please stay to the right, pass on the left.
- When resting or visiting, please move off to the side.
- Avoid herringboning on the set track.
- Respect all trail marking signs.

In Case of Emergency: Dial 911 You are responsible for your own safety on the Golden golf course Nordic ski trails. For evacuations, call 911. Have as much information as possible, including your specific location on the ski trail at 576 Golf Course Drive, Golden BC.
